6. Electronic bids must be submitted to the office through PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before **12.00 hrs 26 February 2026**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
7. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below at 12.30 hrs on 26 February 2026.
8. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format, amounting to a minimum of
